Bunting, Hitting Situations

Pitching Fundamentals Taught

Throwing Grips, Mechanics from the Stretch and Wind up.

Catching Fundamentals Taught

Stance, Footwork, Throwing Position
Framing Pitches, Blocking Balls

Infield Defense Fundamentals Taught

Stance, Footwork, Fielding Position,
Fielding the different types of ground balls, Throwing Position, Covering Bases, Cutoffs, Relays, DP turn

Outfield Defense Fundamentals Taught

Stance, Footwork, Fielding Position,
Circle the ball, Catching the ball on the run,
Fielding the ground ball. Relays, Crow Hop.

Games and Contests

We will play games the last hour of each camp day. We will also have running, throwing and hitting contests.
